Our vision is to better people's lives by promoting the use of evidence-informed social care interventions

What are the aims of INSIA?



- Be at the forefront of social intervention assessment, providing global leadership. We will do this by developing approaches to, and availability of, synthesized research evidence through:
 - supporting international coordination, cooperation, and collaboration in the production of social intervention assessments and systematic reviews
 - developing and promoting methodological principles and guidelines for systematic reviews of social interventions
 - developing and promoting tools and methods to share, translate and adapt systematic reviews of social interventions across different global settings and contexts
 - promoting evidence-informed decision- and policy making in the field of social welfare.

How will we do this?



- Facilitate contact with SIA leaders and scientific staff around the globe
- Provide access to workshops, training sessions and webinars to share expertise, and tools for social intervention assessment
- Provide access to working groups in special interest areas
- Provide access to a web-based communication service to ask and answer questions about assessments, methods and tools
- Develop a repository of good practice, tools and methods developed by and available to members of the network
- Hold a formal annual meeting and quarterly informal meetings to shape the direction of the network
- Develop future position statements and outputs on the challenges facing members across the globe
